GPS for Mariners (GPSM)

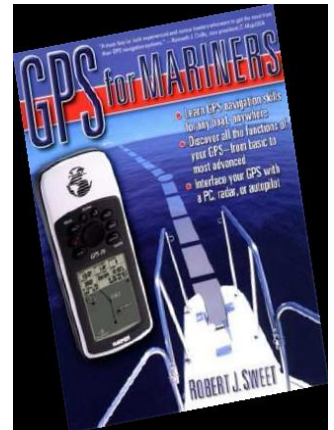
